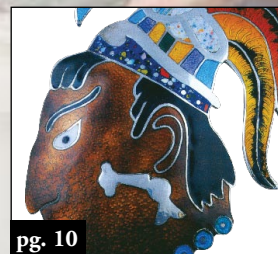
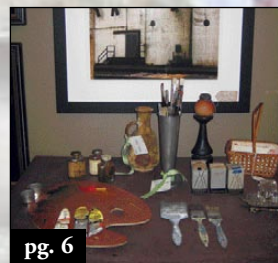


About the Cover

At its Raleigh, N.C., event on June 27, 2009, *Antiques Roadshow* taped the highest-value appraisal in its 13-year history.
